Hunger Fight launches own "Feed the Need to Read" Program

Athletes kick off "Read with Us!" Series

Part of Hunger Fight's mission has always included eradicating illiteracy by providing books to children. As a result, Hunger Fight announced their own, homegrown, Feed the Need to Read program.

The Feed the Need to Read program focuses on emergent literacy skills by delivering three free books to preschool children attending registered daycares each quarter. Books are often not available to those living in poverty, so the Feed the Need to Read program aims to help these children start to build their own libraries. Studies have found proximity to books, along with adult support, can enhance children's learning.

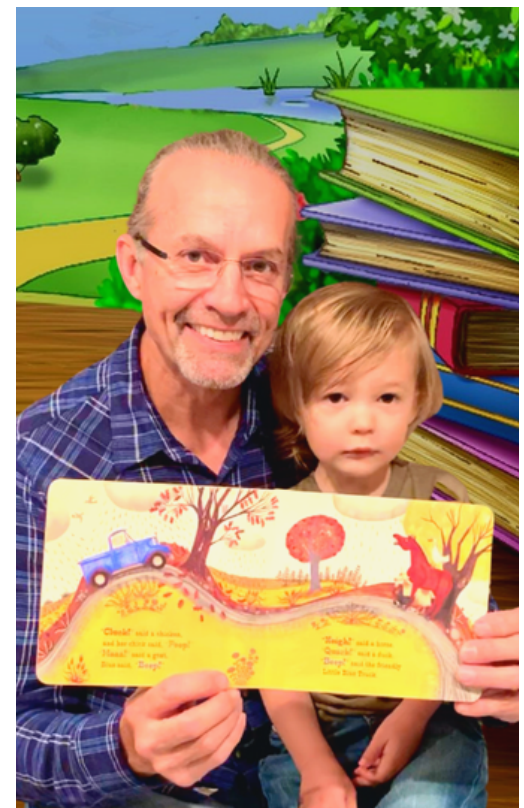
To date, Hunger Fight has already distributed over 134,000 books.

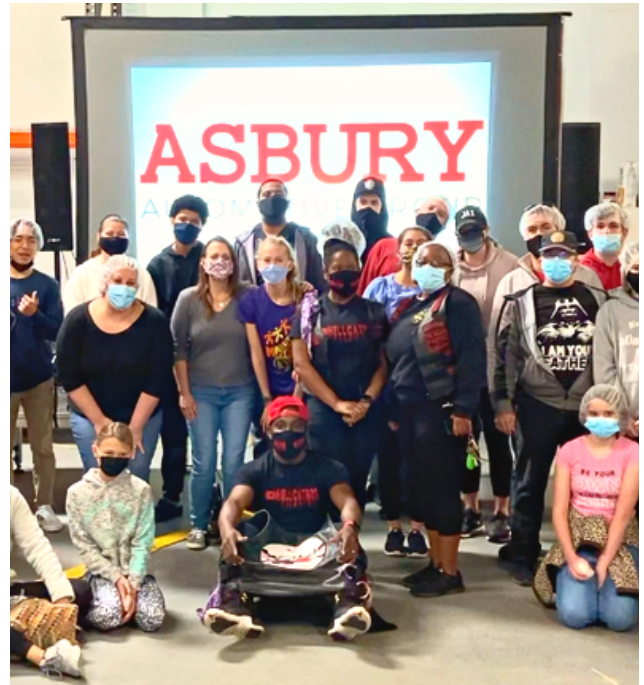

These areas are often considered "book deserts," where access to books is scarce.
